The likely or achieved shortterm and <u>medium-term</u> <u>effects</u> of an intervention's outputs.


«more families have access to clean water»

Positive and negative, primary and secondary <u>long-term effects</u> produced by a development intervention.




Most charities find, that measurement of effectiveness is a relevant topic, which will become more important and should be approached.

Only10-20 % do it systematically






