#### Management of the Charter (i):

Management Committee/Board

- Five members
- Chair: Jeremy Hobbs, Executive Director, Oxfam Int'l
- Oversees sign on process
- Guides development of the Charter
- Ovesees compliance / peer review

#### Complaints committee

- Three members, appointed by founding signatories
- Investigates/deals with complaints against signatories on implementation



### Management of the Charter (ii):

Secretariat

Operated by CIVICUS

All signatories

- Provide feedback on Charter wording to Management Committee
- All report annually against Charter criteria



### **GRI Reporting Standards:**

- Multi-stakeholder consultative process to design compliance and reporting indicators
- For non-profit sector at large, not exclusive to INGO signatories
- Final draft GRI Sector Supplement defining:
  - Reporting Standards (G3 Guidelines)
  - Peer review
  - Independent panel to handle complaints
